

## CSBA DIVISION RULES FORM

\*In order to compete in ANY tournament sanctioned by the Cal Sag Bass Anglers organization, the participating angler MUST sign off on this form. Any competing angler is responsible to read and fully understand the rules/procedures set forth on this form covered in the Mandatory Pre-Tournament Meeting, as well as ALL RULES set forth on our website [www.calsagbass.com](http://www.calsagbass.com). This form points out KEY Rules Specific to the Division.

THANK YOU FOR YOUR PARTICIPATION IN OUR ORGANIZATION. WE ARE DEDICATED AND COMMITTED TO PUTTING THE ANGLERS FIRST!

1. Five Fish Limit – 12” Size
2. Tournament Day Fishing Hours – As Outlined in Tournament Directors Meeting
3. Off Limits of Tournament waters begins 1 day prior to a scheduled event (I.e. A Scheduled event on a Saturday; Off Limits begins Thursday at Dark)
4. Blast Off - The last numbered boat shall be assigned the “Call Boat”. All participating anglers are to assemble in numerical order for blast off procedures. An angler is to STAY directly behind the previous numbered boat in its “Prop Wash ” Area after being called. The Angler MUST break the plane of the Call Boats Bow. ALL specific instructions communicated by the Tournament Director are to be followed. Failure to do so will result in a documented Verbal warning, with additional warnings resulting in a disqualification. We have two blast offs due to the O’Brien Lock. The first Blast off occurs in front of Waterfront Pub. For anglers choosing to “Lock through”, boat numbers should stay in Numerical sequence. There will be no passing unless communication/consent is given from the boat # in front of you. Once anglers choosing to “Lock Through” have passed through Lock Area, they should proceed to the end of the c wall as outlined in numeric sequence for 2nd Blast Off. This is a NO WAKE ZONE area. All competing anglers are to clarify any issues with the Tournament Director regarding Blast Off Procedures in Pre-Tournament Meeting.
5. Check In- As outlined in Tournament Director’s Meeting. Failure to check in On Time will result in penalties (SEE website “RULES”) There is Above Lock Check In and Below Lock Check In(2).
6. OFF LIMIT AREAS (Maps and Descriptions) – Clarification to All Areas outlined in Tournament Directors Meeting
  - (1) No Wake Zone Areas Shown Above (The 1st Bridge by Railroad tracks and the last bridge before Crowley's <Bridge to Bridge>, Above O’Brien Lock to 2nd Bridge, Alsip Boat Ramp Area, Below O’Brien Lock to Bridge at Waterfront Pub. ALL NO WAKE ZONES ARE NO PASSING AREAS.
  - (2) Off Limits Include Point to Point In the River leading into Lake Michigan. An Anglers boat can Not pass line from point to point, but MAY cast into.

- (3) Lake Michigan is OFF LIMITS (see above for any clarification)
- (4) O'Brien Lock Off Limits Area: No Fishing Inside Lock, An Angler's boat may NOT pass the 400 foot markers of lock above and below. You MAY cast into this area.  
AUTOMATIC DQ FOR ANY ANGLER VIOLATING OFF LIMITS AREA RULES & NO WAKE ZONES. ZERO TOLERANCE.
